Also we invite researchers, practitioners, and educators to participate in roundtables and panel discussions.

Panel discussions and round tables:

- ✓ Public health and public health nursing.
- ✓ Preservation of mental health of participants in the educational process and the population of Ukraine in wartime conditions.
- ✓ Challenges in training of nurses for family medicine.

A collection of report abstracts is planned to be published before the start of the conference. Certificates will be issued to the participants and their scientific supervisors.

Options for participating in the conference:

1. Participants may travel to Lviv and speak at the conference offline.
2. Online presentation at the conference via Zoom.

3. Participants may not plan a speech, but only publish the results of the research in the collection of conference materials.

Requirements for report abstracts

- Report abstracts should be written in Ukrainian, English or Polish.
- The text should be typed in the Microsoft Word.
- Use Times New Roman font, size – 14 pt.
- Line spacing - 1,15.
- Paragraph indentation – 1,25 cm.
- Upper, lower, left and right margins – 2 cm.
- Figures and tables should be provided in abstract immediately after the text, where they are mentioned for the first time, or on the next page. Figures and tables should be black and white.
- In the text of the abstract, references should be indicated in two square brackets, according to the list of references (position of the cited publication in the list of references, page) [5, p. 56].
- Pages should not be numbered.
- ***In the upper right corner:*** student's and scientific supervisor's surname and initials (in capital letters), course, specialty, higher education institution (for students); academic degree / title (for academic staff). The name should be aligned to the center, written in capital letters. Below should be a text containing a minimum number of formulas and graphs.
- The volume of material presented in this form should not exceed 10 pages.
- Articles that do not meet the requirements will not be published!
- Authors and scientific supervisors are responsible for the content and editing of materials!

Participants who plan to make a report at the conference should also send a presentation of his/ her speech in pptx format. The number of slides should not exceed 10 slides and should not contain video demonstrations.

Abstract to the article should be written in English and/or Polish (6-10 lines).

KEYWORDS

Keywords in English that reflect the essence of the problem for quick article search in search engines.
